

COST: Tuition \$2780 for 9 weekends (including 2 weekends at Wisdom House in Litchfield, CT, indicated with * below)

Admission Process: It is preferred that applicants have attended an Introductory Weekend or have worked with a Pathwork Helper prior to starting the Pathwork Studies Program. However, exceptions may be made for applicants with experience in spiritual work. Please call the office for an application and submit it no later than September 1, 2007. A non-refundable processing fee of \$50 must accompany the application. After we receive and review the application, an interview will be set up with a Pathwork Helper.

Refund & Cancellation Policy: If you cancel your registration after the first PWS weekend, but before the second weekend, you are responsible for paying tuition for the first weekend, as well as the \$200 non-refundable deposit, which accompanies the contract. Any other payments that have been made toward PWS tuition will be refunded to you. Once you begin the second PWS weekend there are no refunds on the program tuition of \$2780.

Teachers: The class is taught by dedicated, experienced Helpers who have studied the Pathwork for 15 or more years and have completed the seven year Helpership Development Program.

The Pathwork Studies Program is a four-year program dedicated to the teachings found in the Pathwork lectures, which will benefit anyone interested in unblocking the doors to higher consciousness. Each year builds on the year before, with a curriculum of Pathwork lectures which provides a foundation for self-exploration. Students make a commitment for one year at a time.

This program is based on the understanding that through deep self-work, culminating in self-knowledge and self-acceptance, we discover the truth and find God.

Requirements:

During the month, between monthly meetings, students read and study lectures to complete a personal study assignment designated to help them apply the teachings to their own life experience.

Ongoing sessions with a Pathwork Helper are **required**, to support one's process.

Membership in the New York Region Pathwork is also required.

Each weekend includes: eight hours of class time, energy work, community gatherings, process work, and prayer and meditation. Weekends begin on Saturday morning and end on Sunday afternoon. The love and safety that develop during these weekends create an atmosphere that encourages the students to go deep into their process.
